

## Soft wave mittens

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These tiny mittens for 3-9 months baby don't have a thumb. Mittens are knit in the round on double-pointed needles.

Yarn: Angelico Beatrice 100% merino wool 125m/50g

Needles: 3,5mm DPN

### Abbreviations:

st = stich

rnd = round

k = knit

p = purl

k2tog = knit 2 st. together

ssk = slip 1 st, knit 1 st and pull it through the slipped st.

yo = yarn over

Instructions:

(Two mittens are completely identical.)  
Cast on 32 st, join to knit in the round without twisting. Divide all st. between 4 needles 8 st on each needle.

Rnd 1-3: k

Rnd 4-6: p

Repeat rnds 1-6 3 times total (18 rnds).

Rnd 19: k

Rnd 20: \*k2tog, yo\* repeat between \*

Rnd 21: k

Rnd 22-24: p

Then knit next 18 rnds (42 rnds).

Rnd 43: \*k1, k2tog, k10, ssk, k1\* repeat between \*

Rnd 44-49: same as row 43 decreasing k section each rnd.

After the rnd 48 you'll have 2 st on each needle. Pull yarn through the last 8 st and tighten up. Weave in end.



Knit an i-cord (or chain) 25-30cm length and pull it through the holes.
