## **Basic neckwarmer**

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Basic Neckwarmer knitted top down in the round on DPNs or circular needles. This pattern gives you basic approach to the knitted neckwarmer. You can reach totally different view by replacing stoking stitch sections with any other stitch pattern, cables or lace pattern. You can also decorate your neckwarmer with knitted flowers, laces, or cords.

Size: neck circumference 33-35cm (teenager or adult)

Yarn: YarnArt Color Garden 70% acrylic 30% wool, 200m/100g - 1/2 skein

Needles: 4mm DPNs or 80cm circular needles

Pattern tips: 2 by 2 rib = k2, p2 in all rnds Stocking st = k all rnds Garter st = repeat (k 1 rnd, p 1 rnd) 3-in-1 = knit 3 in 1: knit 1 st, make yarn over, knit into the same st

## Neckwarmer

Cast on 88 st, join without twisting. If using DPNs, divide all st to 4 needdles 22 st on each needle. Knit 2 by 2 rib for 18cm or as long as you wish. Continue knitting stocking st at the same time increase 8 st each  $2^{nd}$  rnd as follows:

Rnd 1 and every odd rnd: knit

Rnd 2: k11, \*3-in-1, k21\* repeat between \* 3 times total, 3-in-1, k10 Rnd 4: k12, \*3-in-1, k23\* repeat between \* 3 times total, 3-in-1, k11 Rnds 6, 8, 10, ..., 24: as rnd 4 increasing k sections.

After rnd 24 you'll have 184 st. You can make neckwarmer as long as you wish by keeping on increasing. Once you have reached prefered length, knit 4 rnds garter st with no increases. Cast off, weave ends, block slightly.
